3 – 5	Make-up basics	This is an entry level make-up class covering three different levels of make-up, covering the basic make-up, introduction of color and the projection of color.
6	Camouflage make-up	We often associate make-up with beauty. A growing need for corrective make-up for burn survivors, post-surgical patients, discoloration from port wine stains or birthmarks, and loss of pigmentation due to Vitiligo is being felt. This class teaches corrective application methods and provides a clear understanding of the intent of camouflage make-up.

9	Eyebrow class	Discover another world behind the “Perfect Brow”, how to create the right brow for your client. How to use brow stencils verses free-hand designs.
10	Make-up for catwalk	A sneak peek in designing make-up looks for catwalk, understanding stage lighting when designing make-up looks. Designing your make-up kits focusing on your essential tools for quick and easy make-up applications.
11-12	Editorial make-up	Learning the latest techniques for editorial/print. Understanding the concepts of the “Crème to Powder” method. Creating your make-up designs based on the rendered face chart. Understanding the basics of good lighting for photo shoots.
13 - 14	Theatrical make-up	Make-up has always played an important role in theater, whether in a small play or large production. Make-up can be used to transform any actor into a character. The class is designed to give each student a basic knowledge of theatrical makeup.

16	Make-up for mature skin	Whether you’re sixteen, twenty-four or older, make-up can enhance your looks in many ways. Learn how to implement the latest techniques to achieve timeless results.



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17	Fantasy make-up	Learning to work outside the box, exploring the imaginary world of make-up.
18	Airbrush make-up	Air Brush makeup has grown in popularity, especially with the improved clarity of digital images on television, movies, and in print work. With this method, you can apply makeup with ease. This class dispels the myth that the application is more difficult than using makeup brushes and sponges.
19 - 20	Hair styling class	Learn the basic elements of hairstyling, using the latest techniques, discover the classics styles of the 20's and 30's finishing with styles for today.
